


Figure 2. Results of grab and channel samples (in red) collected during the 2022 summer and fall field activities. Location of the new Oswald showing and the main ankerite zone is shown.




Figure 3. Gold grades (grab and channel) in the polymetallic quartz veins and host rocks at the Oswald showing (NEW DISCOVERY).
